Exodus 17:8-13 2 Timothy 3:14-4:2 Luke 18:1-8

There are some students who study and study only to pass the test and once the test is over they no longer remember what they studied thinking that they don't need to know it any more. Paul, in our second reading, tells the people to remain faithful to what they have learned and believed. They need to hold on to the faith, proclaim the word persistently and encourage one another. Apparently there were some who had become slack in the practice of their faith and they needed to be reminded about what was most important.

How important it is for us to remain faithful to the faith that has been passed on to us! We must not grow lazy or weak in our dedication to Christ and his Church. If we have become less diligent in the practice of our faith, let us rededicate ourselves! If we are struggling at times with our faith, let us pray for the Holy Spirit for comfort and guidance! If we are not encouraging one another (especially our youth!), let us get back on track with our Catholic-Christian living.

- The Church does NOT endorse any particular candidate for elected office.

Propositions:

-The Church may encourage the faithful to support/oppose certain propositions on the ballot. The California Conference of Catholic Bishops has given guidelines to help you on many of the propositions on the ballot. For explanations and guidance go to

cacatholic.org/propositions.

-The Church has taken specific positions on some of the propositions: YES on Prop. 57 (Criminal Sentences); YES on Prop. 62 (Death Penalty Repeal); and NO on Prop. 66 (Death Penalty Appeals).

Let these words to politicians from Pope Francis serve as a guidepost for us:

"I ask everyone with political responsibility to remember two things:
Human Dignity and the Common Good."
